APPELLATION:	Walla Walla Valley
COMPOSITION:	60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Petit Verdot, 15% Syrah, 10% Cabernet Franc
VINEYARDS:	Pepper Bridge, Summit View, Dugger Creek, McClellan and Eritage Vineyards
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.79 TA 0.56 g/100mL Alcohol 14.6% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless-steel fermenters. The cap was punched down two times per day by hand. The wine was transferred to 225 Liter oak barrels to complete primary and secondary fermentation.
AGING:	23 months French oak barrels, 25% new
CASES PRODUCED:	245 cases
SENSORY NOTES:	The Jack Reserve is a limited production wine crafted in handpicked barrels and is aged two years before bottling. 2018 was a near perfect vintage in the Walla Walla Valley with ideal conditions, especially during harvest. The wine has a beautiful bouquet of cassis, black cherry, plum, with hints of violet, sweet herb and vanilla. Rich flavors and a delicious finish make this a perfect wine for gourmet burger night.
