APPELLATION:	Walla Walla Valley
COMPOSITION:	94% Cabernet Sauvignon 3% Merlot 3% Malbec
VINEYARDS:	McClellan, Pepper Bridge, Dugger Creek, and Anna Marie Vineyards
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.81 TA 0.56 g/100mL Alcohol 14.5% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
AGING:	17 months in French oak barrels, 30% new.
CASES PRODUCED:	788 cases
SENSORY NOTES:	<p>The 2020 vintage in the Walla Walla Valley was warmer than the norm with near perfect weather for ripening the fruit used to craft this Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine is a beautiful ruby-color with aromas and rich flavors of blackberry, black cherry, cedar, cocoa, and baking spices. The tannins coat the palate, and the mouthfeel is smooth and supple. Enjoy with a juicy steak and herb roasted morel mushrooms, or a grilled bacon and blue bison burger with truffle fries.
