Walla Walla Valley

COMPOSITION:

82% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Malbec, 9% Merlot

VINEYARDS:

Funk*, Anna Marie*, Summit View, Bacchus, Dugger Creek*, and McClellan* Vineyards

TECHNICAL NOTES:

pH 3.85
TA 0.56 g/100mL
Alcohol 14.5% By Volume

FERMENTATION:

Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING:

17 months in French oak barrels, 30% new.

CASES PRODUCED:

800 cases

SENSORY NOTES:

The suspense of a cooler than average vintage kept our fingers crossed until the very end. Fortunately, we experienced one of the warmest Octobers on record which brought everything to the finish line in style. The 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon is superb. Bright ruby in color with aromas that generously offer a medley of red and black mountain berries. It is met with a blend of cocoa nibs, baking spice, and sweet herb. Cassis and black cherry maintain a strong presence, showing its Cabernet character. It retains a bright acidity...an ode to the cooler vintage. The palate is supple, with fine grained tannins leading to a long pleasurable finish. Cheers!
