FERMENTATION:

Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. The young wine was transferred to neutral French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING:

11 months Neutral French oak barrels

305 cases

SENSORY NOTES:

The 2022 Barbera has a vibrant ruby red color. The aroma is immediately engaging with an abundance of red fruit. Notes of cherry, raspberry, and red currant lead the way. As the wine opens there are underlying tones of spice, including cinnamon and clove, as well as a faint hint of earthiness. Red fruit flavors of bright cherry and cranberry lead to layers of juicy red plum and a touch of black pepper, adding complexity. Simply delicious. The Dugger Creek Barbera is versatile with food and would pair wonderfully with tomato-based pasta dishes, grilled meats, wood-fired pizza, Taleggio cheese, or our favorite, a morel mushroom risotto. Or simply enjoy this rich, satisfying wine while relaxing. Salute!
