FERMENTATION: Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down

two times per day by hand. The wine was transferred to French oak

barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING: French oak barrels, 30% new

SENSORY NOTES: This standout Cabernet-based blend overdelivers at every turn. Sourced

from top vineyard sites in Washington State, it opens with inviting aromas of ripe blackberries, black cherries, and red currants, framed by hints of dried herbs, mocha, and a touch of sweet spice from oak aging. The palate is generous yet balanced, with juicy dark fruit flavors, a lift of fresh acidity, and smooth, approachable tannins. Notes of plum, cocoa, and toasted vanilla carry through a long, satisfying finish. This wine plays like a high roller but comes at a table-friendly price. Enjoy!
