FERMENTATION: Handpicked and hand sorted. Some whole cluster fruit along with

fully destemmed fruit. Fermented in 1.5 and 2 ton open top fermenters with cap punched down by hand 2-3 times per day.

Secondary fermentation finished in barrel and puncheons.

AGING: 17 months in French oak barrels and puncheons. 30% New.

CASES PRODUCED: 296 cases

SENSORY NOTES: Crafted from three distinctive vineyard sites in The Rocks District, our

Reserve Syrah captures the essence of this extraordinary terroir. The aromatics are captivating, with layers of boysenberry, dark cherry, olive, roasted meat, and crushed stone, lifted by subtle notes of pepper and spice. The palate is rich yet refined, offering a velvety texture and savory complexity, with briny olive and umami flavors and hints of cocoa. The finish is long and graceful, a reflection of both the character of The Rocks District and the depth Syrah can achieve in this unique terroir. This wine is beautiful to enjoy now, but will deliver even greater rewards after years in the cellar. Enjoy!
